



Anthony Dutrow

Born: April 27, 1958 in Hagerstown, Md.

Resident: West Friendship, Md.

Family: Wife, Kim; sons James, John and Anthony; brothers Richard Jr. and Sydney "Chip" Dutrow, both trainers, also.

Anthony (Tony) Dutrow is the oldest of three sons of Dick Dutrow, a longtime major Thoroughbred trainer in Delaware, Maryland and New York. The father died in 2000. Anthony Dutrow is based at Philadelphia Park, but has divisions, also in Delaware and New York, with approximately 100 horses in training overall.



As in most racetrack families, Dutrow started working around his father's barn as the ripe old age of 10. His first winner under his own name as trainer came with a horse he bought for himself, Attainable, at Delaware Park in 1975 while still working for his father. He opened his own stable in 1987 in New York. The only trainer besides his father that Dutrow worked was the late Bobby Frankel in California from 1985-87.

He credits Frankel with helping him start his own outfit.

In 2009, Dutrow's barn was led by Seattle Smooth, a multiple graded stakes winner before injury ended her season in mid-summer, and Grade I winner Cat Moves. Other top runners included Indian Way and promising 2-year-old Winslow Homer. The latter was on the Triple Crown trail early this year, but was sidelined by an injury.

In the meantime, A Little Warm has stepped up to provide an initial Kentucky Derby starter for Dutrow.

One of his major winners of the past was Burning Roma, who won the 2000 Futurity and finished fourth in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile. Among other winners: Smart and Fancy, Sherine, Bill Place, Ferocious Fires, Island Sand, Tough Love and Willa on the Move. Of particular interest was an early winner in the claiming ranks for Dutrow – Bonnie's Poker, who went on to become the dam of 1997 Kentucky Derby and Preakness winner Silver Charm.

Dutrow scored his 1,000th victory in October 2007 at Belmont Park.

In 2009, Dutrow's horses rolled up purse earnings of \$5,630,775 for 12th in the U.S. training ranks.
