## NHC Tour Leaderboard Descriptions and Awards

**Overall Leaderboard**: The overall Leaderboard consists of a participant's top six scores accumulated in NHC qualifiers from January 31, 2016 through January 1, 2017. One of the six scores must come from a live, onsite Tournament. An individual who does not score any points in an onsite Tournament will receive a zero for his/her sixth overall year score. For example, during the year, an individual with six online scores but no onsite scores will be credited for his or her top five scores. Participation points will count in the participant's overall score. Participation points (150 points onsite and 50 points online) are capped at 1,500 points for the year.

**Overall Leaderboard Prizes**: The top 20 Tour Points leaders will receive cash prizes totaling \$175,000. The overall winner will receive a cash prize of \$75,000 and a seat to the 2018 NHC. The top finisher will also be eligible for a \$2 million bonus annuity should he or she win the January 2017 NHC. Individuals finishing among the top 150 points leaders on the overall Leaderboard are eligible to automatically qualify into the 2017 NHC. These eligible individuals must NOT have already qualified to the 2017 NHC through their performance in an onsite or online tournament. The top 40 Tour points leaders are each eligible to win a \$25,000 bonus at the 2017 NHC. The individual that finishes highest among those 40 individuals at the 2017 NHC will be awarded \$25,000 and a seat to the 2018 NHC.

**First-half Year Leaderboard**: The First-half Year Leaderboard consist of a participant's top four scores accumulated from January 31 through July 31. One of the four scores must come from a live, onsite Tournament. An individual who does not score any points in an onsite Tournament will receive a zero for his/her fourth first-half year score. For example, during the first half year, an individual with four online scores but no onsite scores will be credited for his or her top three scores. Participation points will count in the participant's first-half score.

**First-half Year Leaderboard Prizes**: The top five Tour Points leaders (All Stars) as of July 31 will each receive a \$10,000 Breeders' Cup Betting Challenge (BCBC) entry or \$10,000 if they have already qualified to the BCBC.

**Second-half Year Leaderboard**: The Second-half Year Leaderboard consists of a participant's top four scores accumulated from August 1 through January 1, 2017. The second-half point totals are reset to zero on August 1. One of the four scores must come from a live, onsite Tournament. An individual who does not score any points in an onsite Tournament will receive a zero for his/her fourth second-half year score. For example, during the second half year, an individual with four online scores but no onsite scores will be credited for his or her top three scores. Participation points will count in the participant's second-half score.

**Second-half Year Leaderboard Prizes**: The top five Tour points leaders will each receive \$10,000 in prize money.

**Cyberstars (NHCQualify.com) Leaderboard**: NHC Tour member accumulating the highest number of NHC Tour Points in 2016 via NHCQualify.com from February 1, 2016 through January 1, 2017 are eligible for awards and bonuses. Participation points DO NOT count in the participant's Cyberstars score.

**Cyberstars Prizes**: The NHC Tour member accumulating the highest number of NHC Tour Points in 2016 via NHCQualify.com from February 1, 2016 through January 1, 2017 will be eligible for a \$1 million bonus annuity if he or she also wins the 2017 NHC. The top five finishers will receive a total of \$25,000 (first-place \$10,000, second-place \$6,000, third-place \$4,000, fourth-place \$3,000 and fifth-place \$2,000).

**NHC Cyber Rookie Leaderboard**: The <u>first-time</u> NHC Tour member who accumulates the highest number of points via NHCQualify.com from February 1, 2016 through January 1, 2017 are eligible for cash prizes. To be eligible, a player must have joined the NHC Tour for the first time in 2016.

**Cyber Rookie Prizes**: The top five rookies will receive a total of \$15,000 (first-place \$5,000, second-place \$4,000, third-place \$3,000, fourth-place \$2,000 and fifth-place \$1,000).
