Tom Rooney | Horse PAC® President | NTRA President and CEO

Tom Rooney served the people of Florida in the U.S. House of Representatives from 2009 to 2019, focusing primarily on economic, agricultural, national security, and military issues. Prior to serving in Congress, Rooney served with the U.S. Army as a lawyer in the JAG Corps. During his tenure, he was Special Assistant U.S. Attorney at Fort Hood, Texas, prosecuting all civilian crimes on post in the 1st Cavalry Division. After completing active duty with the rank of captain, Rooney taught constitutional and criminal law at the U.S. Military Academy at West Point, New York.

He received his J.D. from the University of Miami School of Law and became a member of the Florida Bar in 1999. He also has an M.A. in Political Science from the University of Florida. Rooney played football for Syracuse University and Washington & Jefferson College, where he earned a B.A. in English Literature. Rooney is married to his wife, Tara, and they have three sons.

Joe Bacigalupo

Joe Bacigalupo is Sr. Vice President of External Affairs for the NTRA. Bacigalupo is based in the NTRA's Lexington, Ky. office and heads the organization's development efforts that support the NTRA's federal legislative advocacy work.

In their new roles, both could serve as allies in Washington for the Thoroughbred racing and breeding industry.

2024 LEGISLATIVE SUMMARY

As the representative organization for the Thoroughbred industry, the National Thoroughbred Racing Association (NTRA) directs its lobbying efforts toward legislation that significantly impacts its members and their business engagements in the realms of horse racing, breeding, and pari-mutuel wagering. Additionally, the NTRA advocates for Congressional education initiatives addressing broader issues like agriculture and immigration, which have implications for the entire horse industry. The following outlines key legislative matters pertinent to Thoroughbred breeding and racing during the 118th and 119th Congresses.

ELECTION RESULTS.

Donald Trump secured victory in the presidential election and began his second term in 2025. Republicans also gained the majority in the Senate by flipping four seats previously under Democratic control in West Virginia, Pennsylvania, Montana, and Ohio, resulting in a 53-47 split. In the House of Representatives, Republicans retained control, but by a very slim margin. With President Trump's inauguration, he leads a government aligned with his party's legislative priorities. A key focus for this new Congress will be advancing a comprehensive tax package using the reconciliation process, which enables passage with a simple majority in both chambers. With Republicans in control of the presidency and both chambers of Congress, we can expect progress on provisions from the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act of 2017 that have expired or are set to lapse. A significant area of interest for our industry is the future of Bonus Depreciation, which is anticipated to be a primary focus of legislative efforts and is expected to be included in any package moving forward. In a notable leadership change, Senator Mitch McConnell will no longer serve as the leader of the Senate Republicans next Congress, marking the end of an era for the first time since 2007. McConnell has been a strong ally to our industry, but the NTRA is well positioned to work effectively with his successor, Senator John Thune of South Dakota, as we navigate the legislative landscape ahead.

SUPREME COURT TEMPORARILY UPHOLDS HISA RULES AMID LEGAL BATTLE.

On October 29, 2024, the U.S. Supreme Court granted a temporary stay on a mandate from the Fifth Circuit Court concerning the constitutionality of the Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority (HISA). This move ensures that HISA's rules remain in effect across most U.S. racing jurisdictions for the time being.

The stay, requested by HISA and its supporters, raises the likelihood that the Supreme Court will review constitutional challenges from the Fifth and Sixth Circuits. While both appellate courts upheld HISA's rule-making authority, the Fifth Circuit found its enforcement powers unconstitutional under the non-

delegation doctrine. This doctrine prohibits Congress from granting excessive regulatory authority to non-government entities.

NTRA expects the Supreme Court to address the case and deliver a final ruling by fall 2025 or early 2026.

IMMIGRATION.

The Department of Homeland Security (DHS) announced a final rule that will enable U.S. companies in need of seasonal workers to fill those positions more quickly and efficiently. The rule is designed to modernize and improve the H-2 nonimmigrant visa programs, which allow qualified U.S. employers unable to find sufficient U.S. workers to petition for foreign nationals to fill temporary or seasonal agricultural and nonagricultural jobs.

The final rule eliminates the requirement for U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) to approve petitions for H-2 nonimmigrant status only for nationals of designated eligible countries, removing the need for DHS to compile and publish annual country lists. It also simplifies the rules regarding the 3-year maximum stay period by eliminating "interrupted" stay provisions and introducing a uniform 60-day absence period to reset the 3-year clock.

The final rule also introduces new grace periods and harmonizes existing ones. Specifically, it:

- Adds a 60-day grace period following the cessation of employment, allowing workers to seek new qualifying employment or prepare for departure without violating their status.
- Extends the current 30-day grace period after certain revocations to up to 60 days, covering all revocations of H-2 petition approvals.
- Confirms that H-2 workers maintain status for up to 10 days before the petition's validity period and up to 30 days after its expiration.

The rule also establishes "portability," enabling eligible H-2 workers to begin employment with a new employer immediately after the proper filing of an extension of stay petition, without waiting for its approval. Furthermore, it clarifies that H-2 workers will not be deemed to have failed to maintain their status or denied H-2 classification solely for taking steps toward lawful permanent residency in the United States.

NTRA ENDORSES KEY LEGISLATIVE EFFORTS.

The NTRA endorsed three key pieces of legislation aimed at bolstering investment, financial certainty, and long-term growth in the equine industry. These measures—the Accelerate Long-term Investment Growth Now (ALIGN) Act, the Racehorse Cost

Recovery Act, and the Racehorse Tax Parity Act—represent critical advancements for the Thoroughbred breeding and racing sector and the broader equine economy.

The ALIGN Act, introduced in the House of Representatives by Congressman Jodey Arrington (R-TX), permanently sets the applicable percentage for bonus depreciation at 100%. This is a vital provision for the Thoroughbred industry, as it incentivizes investment, boosts demand at sales, and provides financial certainty for breeders, owners, and buyers. By ensuring long-term depreciation benefits, this legislation will promote reinvestment across the industry while strengthening jobs in farming, training, veterinary care, and other equine-related businesses. The NTRA strongly supports the ALIGN Act as a fundamental measure to maintain the economic vitality of Thoroughbred racing.

Reintroduced by Congressmen Andy Barr (R-KY) and Morgan McGarvey (D-KY) the Racehorse Cost Recovery Act seeks to make the three-year depreciation schedule permanent for yearlings. Previously, Congress had renewed this tax provision annually, but it has remained expired since 2021. Establishing a permanent three-year depreciation schedule will eliminate uncertainty for owners and investors, fostering sustained growth in the Thoroughbred sector.

Also introduced by Congressmen Barr and McGarvey, the Racehorse Tax Parity Act addresses inequities in the tax code by reducing the holding period for equine assets to qualify as long-term capital gains. This change would align the tax treatment of racehorses with other similar assets, ensuring that investors in the equine industry receive fair and consistent tax benefits.

SPORTS BETTING.

Since the 2018 Supreme Court decision that overturned the federal ban on sports betting, the industry has rapidly expanded across the United States. Today, 38 states have legalized sports betting, with 30 also allowing mobile betting. In 2023 alone, Americans wagered a record \$119.84 billion on sports, marking a 27% increase from the previous year. Senator Richard Blumenthal and Congressman Paul Tonko have raised concerns about the public health impacts associated with its widespread legalization. In response, they introduced the SAFE Bet Act, aimed at establishing nationwide consumer protections and standards for the mobile sports gambling industry.

While the SAFE Bet Act was well-intentioned, the NTRA has expressed concerns about its potential repercussions on the horse racing industry's established betting infrastructure. The NTRA believes that introducing new federal standards for sports betting could interfere with existing operations and inadvertently harm regulated betting programs tied to horse racing.

The NTRA is also monitoring Sports Events Trading – a potential new form of sports gambling that may be a backdoor way to introduce sports betting to all 50 states.

VA EQUINE FUNDING HEADED TO SENATE.

On June 5, 2024, the House of Representatives passed H.R.8580 - Military Construction, Veterans Affairs, and Related Agencies Appropriations Act, 2025, with a vote of 209-197. This bill includes an initiative led by Congressman Andy Barr (R-KY) and the NTRA to allocate up to \$5 million in grants for equine therapy under the Veterans Affairs (VA) Adaptive Sports Program. The VA will award these grants to eligible organizations to plan, develop, manage, and implement equine therapy programs for veterans and Armed Forces members with disabilities. The NTRA will now focus on ensuring this provision remains intact.

NTRA 1/4% CHECK-OFF PROGRAM

What is the NTRA 1/4% Check-off Program?

The 1/4% Check-off Program is an NTRA fundraising program that empowers participants at sales hosted by NTRA partners to support the NTRA's federal legislative advocacy services that amplify the horse racing industry's voice in Washington, DC. Buyers and sellers may participate in the Program by pledging \$2.50 for every \$1,000 of a horse's sale price of any or all their horses.

How do I participate?

For Keeneland, Fasig-Tipton, CTBA and WTBOA sales, sellers, consignors, and designated agents may "pre-commit" their pledge on sales entry forms for the Check-off Program. Sellers who miss the deadline for pre-commitments may pledge until the close of sale billing. Buyers may include their contribution when submitting payment. For OBS sales, the NTRA contacts buyers and sellers directly with suggested contribution information.

How much can I contribute?

There is no limit on the amount that can be contributed in the Check-off Program. Sale price determines the contribution amount for a particular horse. Individuals who buy or sell multiple horses may contribute on any or all of them.

How can Federal lobbying help make the horse racing industry more competitive?

We will fight to secure legislation that benefit industry stakeholder groups like horse owners, breeders, racetracks, advance deposit wagering service providers and horseplayers. We will address issues that directly impact racing, such as taxation, internet wagering, immigration, sports betting expansion and matters that affect farmers, ranchers and other agricultural producers.

How does the NTRA lobby on Capitol Hill?

NTRA fields a government relations team based in Washington, DC, that is led by former U.S. Congressman and current NTRA President and Chief Executive Officer, Tom Rooney. NTRA also coordinates with the American Horse Council on legislative advocacy issues that affect all equine breeds and disciplines.

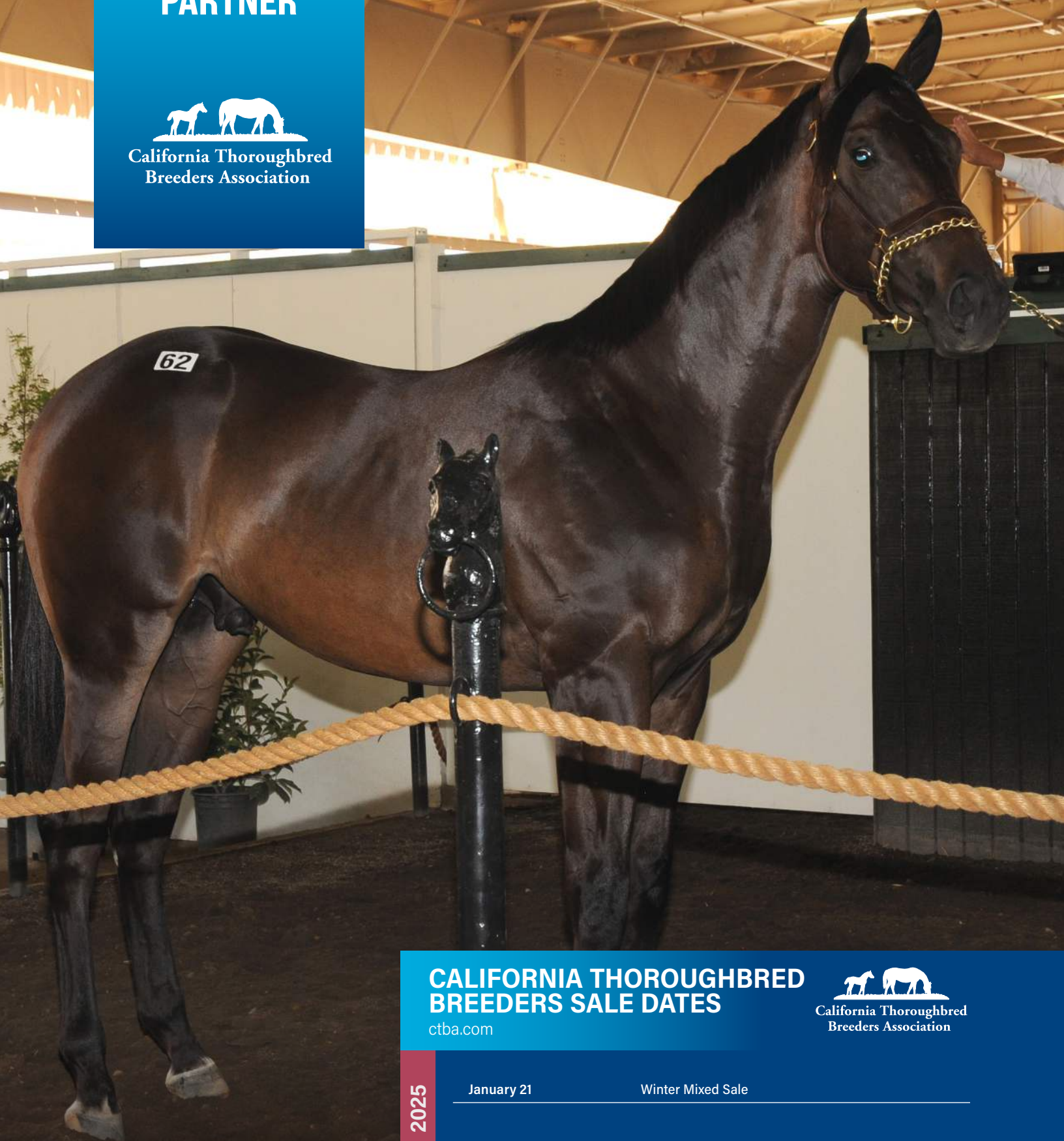

NTRA'S FEDERAL LEGISLATIVE STRATEGY

The NTRA's government relations team performs a broad array of legislative advocacy services for the horse racing and breeding industry. Working closely with the NTRA membership and Board of Directors, the team determines the industry's governmental priorities and then develops a comprehensive legislative strategy to achieve these priorities. The current strategy includes building relationships with members of Congress and their staffs, educating them about industry issues and concerns and introducing lawmakers and staff to industry members in the field.

The government relations team uses a combination of resources to enhance its presence and effectiveness on Capitol Hill. NTRA President and Chief Executive Officer, Tom Rooney, served as a U.S. Congressman for 10 years and has a strong network of federal legislators and their staffers who assist the team. Anchoring team's efforts is the formation of an NTRA office on Capitol Hill that opened in June 2022. Additionally, the team is in daily contact with established lobbying firms in Washington, DC, to help move horse racing's legislative agenda through Congressional processes of meeting with Congressional staffers and members of Congress, bill drafting, committee mark-ups, hearings, and votes.

One essential element of maintaining this effective presence in Washington is robust fundraising. The NTRA primarily secures financial support through its Legislative Action Campaign's ¼% Check-off Program at major Thoroughbred auctions. Industry members who buy and sell at Keeneland, Fasig-Tipton, Ocala Breeders' Sales Company (OBS), California Thoroughbred Breeders and Owners Association and the Washington Thoroughbred Breeders & Owners Association may contribute one quarter of one percent of each horse's sale price to help fund the Campaign.

Horseplayers who join the NHC Tour at a certain membership level also are considered contributors to the NTRA's Legislative Action Campaign through their membership.

Campaign finance also is important to NTRA advocacy. The NTRA government relations team organizes and participates in fundraisers on behalf of Horse PAC®, the political action committee of the NTRA. Horse PAC® had disbursed more than \$4.9 million to upwards of 375 federal political candidates and leadership PACs since 2002. [Click here](#) to read the 2024 Horse PAC® Annual Report.

Another component of the NTRA's government advocacy efforts for more than a decade was the NTRA Safety and Integrity Alliance. Formed in 2008, the Alliance promoted national uniformity through a national Code of Standards and Accreditation process covering six areas: 1) injury reporting and prevention; 2) a safer racing and training environment; 3) uniform medication, testing, and penalties; 4) jockey safety and welfare; 5) aftercare and transition of retired racehorses; and 6) wagering security. The Alliance proved to be helpful in the formation and passing of the Horseracing Integrity and Safety Act (HISA), a federal law that creates uniform standards in two areas: anti-doping and medication control and racetrack safety to protect horses and jockeys. HISA's racetrack safety program went into effect on July 1, 2022, replacing the Alliance. HISA's anti-doping and medication control program began on May 22, 2023.

The horse racing industry is part of a \$37 billion agri-business that supports nearly half a million jobs touching every state. In 2024, more than \$11.2 billion was wagered on horse racing nationwide. Governmental regulation and oversight are critical to horse racing's economic development and long-term survival. For this reason, the NTRA dedicates significant resources to protecting and promoting horse racing on Capitol Hill.

Starting with a landmark 2000 amendment to the Interstate Horseracing Act that paved the way for online betting on pari-mutuel horse racing, the NTRA has built a significant presence on Capitol Hill. The NTRA strengthened its presence even as federal lobbying expenditures by all industries have skyrocketed. The chart below shows the tremendous growth in lobbying expenditures across all industries, including the gambling sector.
