

NHC Tour Leaderboard Descriptions and Awards*

Overall Leaderboard: The overall Leaderboard consists of a participant's top seven scores accumulated in NHC qualifiers from February 10, 2018 through January 12, 2019, unless otherwise noted. One of the seven scores must come from a live, onsite Tournament. An individual who does not score any points in an onsite Tournament will receive a zero for his/her seventh overall year score. For example, during the year, an individual with seven online scores but no onsite scores will be credited for his or her top six scores. Participation points will count in the participant's overall score. Participation points (150 points onsite and 50 points online) are capped at 750 points for the first half-year leaderboard and 750 for the second-half leaderboard. Participation points will be capped at 1,500 points for the 2018 overall Tour leaderboard.

Overall Leaderboard Prizes: The top 20 Tour Points leaders will receive cash prizes totaling \$285,000. The overall winner will receive a cash prize of \$100,000 and a seat to the 2020 NHC. The overall winner will also be eligible for a \$5 million bonus annuity should he or she win the January 2019 NHC. The top 40 Tour points leaders, based on the 2018 overall leaderboard standings as of January 13, 2019 (unless otherwise noted), each are eligible to win a \$25,000 bonus at the NHC that will be awarded to the individual that finishes highest among those 40 individuals at the NHC (not the consolation contest). The winner will also receive an entry into the 2020 NHC.

First-half Year Leaderboard: The First-half Year Leaderboard consists of a participant's top four scores accumulated from February 10 through July 29, unless otherwise noted. One of the four scores must come from a live, onsite Tournament. An individual who does not score any points in an onsite Tournament will receive a zero for his/her fourth first-half year score. For example, during the first half year, an individual with four online scores but no onsite scores will be credited for his or her top three scores. Participation points will count in the participant's first-half score capped at 750 participation points.

First-half Year Leaderboard Prizes: The top five Tour Points leaders as of July 29, unless otherwise noted, will each receive a \$10,000 Breeders' Cup Betting Challenge (BCBC) entry or \$10,000 if they have already qualified to the BCBC.

Second-half Year Leaderboard: The Second-half Year Leaderboard consists of a participant's top four scores accumulated from July 29 through January 12, 2019, unless otherwise noted. The second-half point totals are reset to zero on July 30. One of the four scores must come from a live, onsite Tournament. An individual who does not score any points in an onsite Tournament will receive a zero for his/her fourth second-half year score. For example, during the second half year, an individual with four online scores but no onsite scores will be credited for his or her top three scores. Participation points will count in the participant's second-half score capped at 750 participation points.

Second-half Year Leaderboard Prizes The top five Tour Points leaders as of January 12, 2019, unless otherwise noted, will each receive a \$10,000 Breeders' Cup Betting Challenge (BCBC) entry or \$10,000 if they have already qualified to the 2019 BCBC.

Rookie Leaderboard: Any first time NHC Tour member will be eligible for a \$5,000 bonus awarded to the "NHC Tour Rookie of the Year." The NHC Rookie of the Year will be the first-time Tour member who accumulates the highest number of NHC Tour points via all NHC qualifiers online or on-track.

Participation points (150 points onsite and 50 points online) are capped at 750 points for the first half-year leaderboard and 750 for the second-half leaderboard. Participation points will be capped at 1,500 points for the 2018 overall Rookie Tour leaderboard. In the event of a tie, the NHC Tour Rookie of the Year bonus winner(s) will be based on the individual who wins the most NHC qualifying tournaments between February 10, 2018 and January 12, 2019, unless otherwise noted. In the further event of a tie, prize money will be divided equally among those tied.

Rookie Prizes: The top five rookies will receive a total of \$15,000 (first-place \$5,000, second-place \$4,000, third-place \$3,000, fourth-place \$2,000 and fifth-place \$1,000).

Top 50 Non-Qualified Leaderboard: A special, separate top 50 leaderboard will be maintained to include those players NOT already qualified for the NHC through an official NHC on-track or online contest. The top 50 individual overall points leaders at year-end on the top 50 leaderboard will automatically qualify into the 2019 NHC.
